(An encryption process that demonstrates the authenticity and integrity of the document)

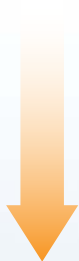
- 256-bit encryption
- Self-reliant with independent verification
- Tamper-evident detects tampering efforts and invalidates signed documents if they are altered in any way
- Certificate of Authenticity tracks date, time, email address and IP address
- Audit Log tracks unique session ID, document ID, signer ID and location ID

- Third Party Certificate of Authority validates and certifies the signed documents
- SMS authentication option
- Password option
- Knowledge-based authentication (KBA) option
- Service is hosted in a SAS70 Type II datacenter with biometric security
